G	Number of Cases – African American	Total number of new cancer cases in African Americans
H	Age-Adjusted Rate (per 100,000 of Population)	Incidence rate per 100,000 of population for total population age-adjusted to the 2000 U.S. standardized population
I	Age-Adjusted Rate – Male (per 100,000 of Population)	Incidence rate per 100,000 of population for males age-adjusted to the 2000 U.S. standardized population
